### **Objective(s) for the Committee Call**

- Proposed July meeting topics:  
Waste Area Group (WAG) 10 Proposed Plan briefing  
Acceleration Retrieval Project (ARP)-III Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA)  
WAG 7 Draft Record of Decision (ROD)  
WAG 10-08 Remedial Design/Remedial Action (RD/RA)

The WAG 10 proposed plan will be release August 13, 2008. There is a 30 day public review period. Nicole Hernandez will provide a preview of the document at the July meeting. It would be best if the CAB could meet in subcommittee during the comment period to produce a recommendation by September 12, 2008.

The ARP-III EE/CA will be released in the next day or two. There is a 30 day public review period. The RWMC committee should have a recommendation prepared for deliberation for the July meeting. Lisa will mail out the document as soon as it is released. A committee call will be scheduled if the CAB decides they would like to provide a recommendation.

The WAG 7 draft ROD doesn't go out for public comment, but Mark Arenaz will provide an overview at the July meeting explaining the selection process and the waste areas.

The WAG 3 Operable Unit 3-14 Tank Farm Soils ROD was signed in May 2007. Now DOE has prepared and will issue a final work plan that details how they will implement the ROD. Nicole Hernandez will provide an overview at the July meeting of the work plan.

The committee decided they would like to have a tour of the Middle Butte Cave and other historical sites to gain an understanding of tribal relations. They would like to have also toured PBF, SL-1, and the Borax reactors, but site activity will limit access of those areas during that week of July. Willie Preacher will additionally provide an informational presentation at the July meeting on understanding tribal relations with the INL site.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The July meeting schedule will be modified to accommodate a half day tour on July 15 and a full day public meeting on July 16.
