**INTEC (Tank Closure) ROD, Waste Determination, Begin Grouting Tanks**

Buxton had questions about contaminated sand beneath the tanks. Quigley explained that the sand is between the vault and the tank and will be grouted with the tank. The sand in the vault area is part of the RCRA unit. DOE will include additional explanation at the next meeting. The committee asked for the diagram of a jet to be included.

DOE plans to receive the Nuclear Regulatory Commission report tomorrow. Then the plan is to have the final waste determination and record of decision to the DOE field office and contractor by November 8<sup>th</sup> and if the weather holds, immediately start grouting.

Keith Lockie will provide an update and the above mentioned additional explanation at the November meeting.
