### **Objective(s) for the Committee Call**

- Discuss the draft recommendation for Radioactive Waste Management Complex Stakeholder Involvement.

### **Summary**

Alan Jines asked if logistical information could be included on how certain items from the recommendation could be implemented. Include why it was put in the order listed and how the CAB thinks those items should work out. It would also be helpful to revisit priority setting to reflect the public perspective instead of only the CAB perspective. DOE-ID is looking to the CAB as a subset of the public to achieve information pertaining to the public. Committee agreed to discuss these inclusions with the full board at the March meeting. There were no other changes identified.

There is not much feedback information Jeff Perry can provide in a presentation regarding the stakeholder involvement plan, since recommendation has not been received from the CAB. However, DOE-ID made a trip to DC and met with Inez Triay (EM-3) and then also did a fact finding study in Colorado with the EPA, State, DOE, representatives of local government, and contractors and gathered a lot of information that could be reported to the CAB. Committee agreed they would like to have this presentation. Update title to public involvement planning to reflect this update in topic.

Mary Willcox said Jeff Perry would like some time to provide correlation of assay results in the waste findings versus the inventory map grid, status on drum fire investigation follow-up, and detections of uranium in the SDA well instead of including it in Rick Provencher's status report. Final report for the drum fire is planned to be distributed this Friday, March 3, 2006. Committee agreed to plan for this presentation instead of having Rick include in his status. Plan for a 30 minute presentation.
