Objective(s) for the Committee Call

- Discuss Recommendation #141
- Discuss the status of anticipated documents and review and finalize meeting agenda.

The Idaho National Laboratory Environmental Management Citizen's Advisory Board (INL-EM CAB) discussed Recommendation #141, written by Willie Preacher. The title was changed from "Proposed Plan" to "Preferred Alternative". A few grammatical changes were made. A bullet point was added, expressing the CAB's financial and cultural resource concerns over using Road T-25 and supporting the preferred recommendation to close Highway 20/26 during off-peak hours to transport the waste from the Material Fuel Complex (MFC) to Idaho Nuclear Technology and Engineering Center (INTEC). The letter was approved by consensus after the necessary changes were made.

The only current anticipated document is the Remote-Handled Waste Disposition Project Environmental Assessment, which is being addressed by Recommendation #141.

There were no issues concerning the finalization of the meeting agenda. The agenda met with consensus and was approved.

Fred Sica brought up the issue of Yucca Mountain and the possibility of DOE changing direction with the new administration. He suggested that it would be important for the CAB to review a report written by John Sackett discussing the INL buildings, their use and plans for disposition. Mr. Sica suggested that the CAB may need to look at the option of waste reprocessing as an alternative to Waste Disposition. Mr. Sica will email the CAB, the liaisons, and support staff a link to the report.
