Mark Shaw questioned the committee on what they would like to see for the groundwater tours. The CAB expressed additional interest in the IE-06 lysimeter at the RWMC, ICDF, and grouting. All agreed it would be difficult to “see” a groundwater tour. Shaw suggested that they could focus on the D&D sites and discuss the groundwater topics as practicable. He also informed the committee that the grouting of the first big tanks at the Tank Farm Facility had been finished yesterday. Doug Weir asked where the proposed GNEP project would take place and thought it would be interesting to see the proposed locations. Shaw said in addition, some CERCLA ecological monitoring might be taking place and would be interesting to see (under the WAG 10-08). He could additionally discuss the groundwater model for WAG 10-08. The committee liked that idea and agreed that any additional interesting locations Shaw could add would be of interest to the CAB.
